

EDUCATION PROGRAMS

INTEGRATING THEATER INTO LIVES

Baltimore Center Stage is committed to offering students, families and educators world-class theater and educational experiences. We serve nearly 13,000 students per year, through student matinees, and in-class programs. Our arts-integration and professional development workshops help students and teachers use theater to drive academic learning. Our family programs offer parents and children unique opportunities to play and learn together.

FOR SCHOOLS

STUDENT MATINEES

Student groups get the whole performance, uncut, for just \$15 per ticket. Free tickets and transportation are available to Baltimore City Public Schools. School groups have access to supplemental materials and the opportunity to participate in pre-show and post-show workshops and discussions.

YOUNG PLAYWRIGHTS FESTIVAL

Our Young Playwrights Festival (YPF) begins with in-class workshops conducted in partnership with area schools, and culminates in a professionally produced performance of student work at Baltimore Center Stage. Students in grades K-12 throughout the state are eligible to submit their plays for consideration. YPF lesson plans and curricular resources are available for classroom teachers. Subsidies are available for Baltimore City Public Schools.

ARTS INTEGRATION

In partnership with schools and classroom teachers, Baltimore Center Stage offers arts-integrated workshops that address Common Core and National Core Arts Learning Standards through theater-making. Our professional teaching artists co-plan and co-facilitate lessons that engage students and drive academic learning in ELA and Social Studies. Subsidies are available for Baltimore City Public Schools.

DRAMA CLUB

Drama Club is a free, yearlong theater training program open to young actors (ages 15 to 18) in Baltimore and throughout Maryland. Ensemble members engage in an interactive rehearsal process full of high-energy games, ensemble-building activities, and exercises designed to cultivate creative and life skills. Together, they collaborate with Baltimore Center Stage teaching artists and a director to rehearse and present a play in the Head Theater at Baltimore Center Stage, in June 2018.

CAMP CS

This two-week-long day camp, designed for students in grades 1-12, uses the performing arts to inspire creative confidence, self expression, and self-awareness. Three two-week sessions are available from June-August.
